 make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner
 and forme following first and principally commanding my Soul
 into the hands of Omnipotency God my Creator hoping through
 the alone Merit of Jesus Christ my blessed Saviour and
 Redeemer to receive the full pardon of all my sins and to
 inherit eternal life my body to commit to the Earth to be
 buried in the Vault in Framford Chapple Yard belonging to
 our family at the direction of my Executor hereafter named
 and as to such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God of his
 mercy to bestow on me I dispose hereof as followeth itemizing
 & giving devise and bequeath unto my loving Brother Thomas
 Gillman all that my moiety or half part of the farm called
 Southwood with the Outhouses lands and appurtenances....
 thereto belonging situate lying and being in the several
 parishes of Chelmsford and Writtle in the said County of
 Essex and now or late in the tenure or occupation of Dame
 Elizabeth Widow or her Assigns also all that my moiety or
 half part of the farm called Coopers with the Outhouses -
 lands and Appurtenances thereto belonging situate lying
 and being in Rayndon Woods in the County aforesaid and
 now or late in the tenure or occupation of Thomas Dunnington
 jun^r or his Assigns also all that my leaseage or tenement
 and farm called Hordwicks with the Outhouses lands and
 Appurtenances thereto belonging situate lying and being
 on the South end of Horne Church in the said County of Essex
 and now or late in the tenure or occupation of William
 Bridges jun^r or his Assigns and also all that my leaseage
 or tenement or farm with the Outhouses lands and
 Appurtenances thereto belonging situate lying and being
 in Wixford in the said County of Essex and now or late in
 the tenure or occupation of Griffin Saltmarsh his Assignee or
 Assigns to have and to hold the said several leaseages or
 tenements lands and premises with the Appurtenances or
 such part hereof so as aforesaid bequeathed unto my said
 Brother Thomas Gillman and the heirs of his body lawfully
 begotten or to be begotten and for want of such issue to give
 devise and bequeath all the aforesaid leaseages or tenements
 lands and premises with the Appurtenances unto my loving
 Brother John Gillman & after his death unto my said loving
 brother John Gillman the sum of eight hundred pounds of
 lawful Pounds of great Britain to be paid him by my Executor
 hereafter named within twelve months next after his death.
 Item I give devise and bequeath unto Mr. Henry Peacock
 100 Pounds of the Joseph Peacock and to Mrs. Fowler his wife
 wife of Mr. Charles Fowler the sum of one hundred pounds
 apiece of like lawful money to be severally paid them within

to twelve months next after my decease Item I give devise and bequeath unto my said loving & brother Thomas Gillman the sum of £100 hundred and fifty pounds of like lawful money to trust for him to dispose of his same amongst my Sarah Varty's five children namely Gilbert & Thomas Charles Benjamin and Sarah Varty either equally or in such parts and proportions as any of them shall best deserve and in such manner and out such lines as my said Brother Thomas Gillman shall think fit. Item I give devise and bequeath unto James Booth his Clerk and other Master Court Executrix of the Charity School of Runmford. — aforesaid the sum of fifty pounds of like lawful money to be paid them within six months next after my decease in Event that they do pay the same to the Treasurer of the said School for the time being to the intent the said money may be put out at interest for the use and benefit of the Charity Children of the said School Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Cousin Joseph Newdick and Mary his wife and Christopher Bayley of Runmford aforesaid and to each of them the sum of ten pounds to buy them a pair of Plate to keep in remembrance of me Item I give and bequeath unto my Uncle Richard Bayley among Aunts Sarah and Mary Bayley of Runmford aforesaid to my Aunt Sarah Bayley of Bromleyng and to my Cousin Mary Ditts Nutrich and Constance his wife twenty shillings apiece to buy each of them a Ring to wear in remembrance of me Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Sister Elizabeth Gillman my diamond Ring Item I give and bequeath unto Nicholas Ditts my Brother Gillman's Apprentice the sum of twenty pounds to be paid him within six months next after my decease and also ten pounds to buy him a pair of Plate to keep in remembrance of me Item I give to the poor of Runmford Collier Row Droke Hill and Barold Woodwards the sum of three pounds in Bread to be distributed amongst them by the Chappell Gardens within ten days after my decease also all the Rest and residue of my Goods Chattels Plate Rings church ready money debts owing to me and all other my personal Estate whatsoever not before disposed after my debts & charges and expences paid discharged and accounted & give and bequeath unto my said loving & brother Thomas Gillman and make him sole Executor of his my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made in witness whereof I the said Samuel Gillman to this my last Will and Testament countersigned in two sheets of paper have to each sheet set my hand and affixed my Seal the three and twenty day of June in the eighth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord King George of great Britain & Anno Regni 1722 Samuel Gillman. Signed sealed published and declared by the said Executor to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who subscribed our names altogether in the said testator's presence Mr Collier Row Mrs Sarah Thomas Williams
